What is Lunch Bunch?

Lunch Bunch gives your child some additional time at school by offering the opportunity to share a meal with friends, learn important social skills and participate in planned enrichment activities. Children engage in stories, songs, free play, games, art activities and gym or playground time. The earlier drop-off or later pick-up time is also a benefit for parents who may need a little extra time in their day.

When is Lunch Bunch?

Lunch Bunch starts on the first day of school, September 10th. Children may attend Lunch Bunch on their scheduled school days.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lunch Bunch starts at the end of the school day• Teachers escort children to the Lunch Bunch area• Time frame = 11:30am-1:00pm (1½ hours)• Pick up is at 1:00pm using the car line• Cost = \$16.00/day	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lunch Bunch starts at 11:30• Parents walk children to the school entrance• Time frame = 11:30am-12:15pm (45 minutes)• At 12:15, children are escorted to their classes• Cost = \$8.00/day

Additional information:

- Send your child to school with a nutritious nut-free bag lunch (clearly labeled with their name) and a beverage. If your child is a morning student, the lunch will be refrigerated.
- Payment is received daily, so just place the fee in your child's lunch box. You may pay with cash or check (made payable to Hillside Preschool). You may also pay weekly or even monthly if you like. We keep track of the number of days your child attends.

Note: Lunch Bunch payments **should not** be combined with tuition.

- Please **do not** send any lunch items that need to be heated.
- Teachers are happy to assist with opening packages. Uneaten food will be returned so you know what your child is and is not eating.
- **Due to food allergies, please do not include peanut butter or any peanut/nut products in your child's lunch.**
